

Deer Valley Women's Golf Club
General Membership Meeting February 9, 2022
1:00pm – RH Johnson Lecture Hall

Call to order 1:02pm.

Opening inspirational message by President Vicki Mitchell.

In Attendance: Sign in sheet attached.

Two index cards were given out to each attendee, asking them to write their "I like" and "I dislike" about being a member of Deer Valley Women's Golf Club and drop them in the box as you were leaving.

Treasurer's report was given by President Vicki Mitchell since Cheryl Sherwood was not in attendance. There was a balance of \$6898.36 as of 1/31/2022. The Treasurer Report will now be posted on the website.

President Vicki Mitchell gave a breakdown of how our \$25 membership fees were broken down. Hole in Ones receive \$1, Birdies/Eagles receive \$3, Tournaments receive \$6, Administration receives \$5 and Social receives \$10.

1. AGA – Teresa Pirkle announced the top results for medallion will be available on the website after the round in March.
2. Birdies/Chip Ins – Pam Gwin reported there were 28 birdies in December, 62 in January and 27 in February. There were 38 chip ins for January and 21 for February. There was one eagle by Pam Marchant.
3. Birthdays – Teresa Gasaway was not present.
4. Bulletin Boards – Jean Novak had no report.
5. CAGD – Marlys Stannebein was not present.
6. Rings/Tournaments – Lois Petrik reported there are 132 women signed up for rings.
7. Directory/Rules – Sherry Skogrand had nothing to report.
8. Handicaps – Sherry will discuss later in meeting.
9. Historian – Dorine Murray reported the archive book is available for viewing.
10. Membership – Janice Runnels reported there are 174 regular members and 8 social.
11. New Member Orientation – Pepper Trautman reported she is all caught up with new members.
12. Photographer – Pat Roberts will be taking pictures on Tuesdays and putting them on the website and on facebook.
13. Publicity – Marla Duffield reported results are turned in weekly and if you want something published to please get it to her.
14. Safety – Sharon Powell reported that if you see something hazardous to please report it to her and that pictures are very helpful.
15. Sunshine – Terry Nicks asked that if you know of any illnesses, injuries or deaths within the club to please let her know so she can send a greeting card.

16. Social – Marlene Gates asked that members please sign up for the Spring Luncheon which will be held on Wednesday, March 23 at Palm Ridge. Sign up and money is due by Friday, March 11 and no latecomers can be added since Panera Bread is catering the event. It is also BYOB.
17. Team – Chris Falasco reported there are two more matches, both against Trail Ridge, and that Deer Valley is only behind by 6 points (net). Last match is on March 4. The schedule is on the website.
18. Website – Linda Leng reported that more and more content is being added to the website so please check it periodically.

Items of Discussion:

Players are needed for the GPDT which is the tournament for the four clubs, one member from each club is on each foursome. We currently have only 20 signed up and we need 32 minimum and 36 ideally. The event will be at Grandview on March 8. Cost is \$25 plus green fees. There will be an ABCD player on each team. There are door prizes, a continental breakfast and lunch afterward which will be held outside at Kuentz. Husbands will be watching the carts with the clubs. Pat Roberts asked if someone could take pictures since she will be out of town. Contact Teresa Pirkle if you can participate.

Plaque Replacement – Teresa Pirkle reported that two plaques are missing, the Ace and Aces and the Presidents Cup. These plaques are outside of the club and were probably damaged in a windstorm. The cost to replace them was discussed and varied from \$35 for the backboard and \$10 for each plate to \$200 per plaque with added plates at no cost. All of the information from the plaques is on the website and in the archives so a show of hands was taken to determine if the cost should be incurred to replace the plaques. The majority was to not replace them. The current plaques will be given to the historian.

New Logo – Mary Gaynett has created a new logo and a sample was passed out. The logo is available to be put on clothing, visors, hats, towels, a window decal, bags, birdie juice bottles and glassware. Mary has an order form where members can complete their choices and Mary will fulfill orders twice a month. You can pay her directly.

Green Tee Guidelines/Rule Info – Sherry Skogrand reported that the bylaws were amended in January, 2019 and again recently in regard to green tee play. There needs to be 6 players to have a green flight. A handicap of 30 or higher is required to be eligible to play green tees and be able to be eligible for sweeps payouts. The \$2 to sweeps is required regardless since it is part of our bylaws. Once a player is eligible for green tees, they stay with green even if their handicap goes down. If a member chooses to play green tees but is not eligible based on their handicap, they are not eligible for sweeps money. There was discussion about the world handicap system and the soft and hard caps that can be put on your index. Once your handicap hits a low, it is held there for a rolling year and can only go up or down based on the cap. You know if you have a cap if there is an “I” next to your handicap on GHIN. If you have a legitimate reason to ask for this to be adjusted due to a medical reason, talk with Sherry.

ByLaws – President Vicki Mitchell reported there are some bylaws that need to be changed and they are being reviewed. Sue Smith asked about guests and the number of times they can play with the club. A SCW rec card holder can be a guest 6 times, a non-rec card holder can be a guest only 4 times.

ABCD – President Vicki Mitchell reported that on March 15, 2022, the game of the day is going to be colorama and that the foursomes will be determined by ABCD players. On the 8th of March, indicate on your play sheet if you are playing on the 15th and at what time you would like to play and your foursomes will be determined for you. This is a way to get to meet new members of the club. We are one of the only clubs that does not do this on a regular basis.

Summer Play Courses – A handout was distributed showing the dates and courses that DVWG will be utilizing this summer while Deer Valley is closed down. We will be rotating instead of only playing at one course. The website will list the course and the game. It was discussed that Pebblebrook has a combo tee combination of green and red. The ability to only play green tees with a handicap of more than 30 at Deer Valley is waived on the other courses.

Nancy's schedule – there was a handout of Nancy's schedule and it is also posted on the website. Any issues or concerns in regard to Nancy should be taken to President Vicki Mitchell for her to address.

Teeing off on Back 9 – President Vicki Mitchell has been asked if we can sometimes start on the back 9 so she discussed this with Nibby and was told it was not possible since the course is utilized by others after DVWG is done teeing off.

Nominating Committee – We need three people to fill the committee to find new candidates for the 2023 season. Please let Vicki Mitchell know if you would like to be on this committee. New candidates must be posted on the bulletin board at least 30 days before the vote can be taken in the Fall.

Awards – The awards given at the Christmas luncheon have been traditionally in pin form. President Vicki Mitchell reported that they can also be in ballmarker form and a vote was taken to determine if that would be preferred. A unanimous vote decided that ball markers would be used instead of pins.

A question was posed in regard to the Blind Bogey and how that number was chosen each week. There is a box with the blind bogey scores (65-85) and the starters draw three of them. If a member has a net score of the first number chosen, that number is used. If not, they go onto the second number chosen and so forth. It was asked if Nancy can check the box to be sure all of the numbers are in there.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:13pm.
